On a typical day in the Stitch Bar kitchen, Darren is responsible for working through various tasks on the prep list and getting ready for a fast-paced dinner service.

"I really enjoy learning new skills," Darren said. From crafting cheese balls for tapas to filleting fish, the job gives Darren the chance to pick up kitchen skills every day.

Darren has also learned the importance of staying organised, prioritising tasks, maintaining a good work flow, and being reliable. He loves being part of a team, and enjoys the social aspect of meeting new people through work.

"The program has enabled me to learn new skills, become a part of a team environment, and have an income that is regular," Darren said.

One of the promising things Darren sees in his career choice is the potential to travel overseas. Once he completes his qualification, Darren plans to look for work opportunities abroad, starting with the United States. Darren's favourite saying

sums up his optimism about the future: "Ain't no mountain high enough."
